

Nokero provides lighting for Typhoon Haiyan victims



ShelterBox uses Nokero to bring light to 50,000 victims across the Philippines after Typhoon Haiyan.

Our customer: ShelterBox is a UK-based non-profit that provides emergency shelter and supplies to support communities around the world affected by disaster and humanitarian crisis.

The Situation: ShelterBox needed solar lights to rapidly respond to the destruction caused by Typhoon Haiyan. The only other lighting alternative was kerosene lanterns which are dirty, dangerous, expensive and unreliable in storms.

The Solution: Nokero was able to quickly respond to the crisis and shipped 10,000 N200 solar light bulbs to ShelterBox's team in the Philippines. The lights were shipped directly to Cebu, Philippines and arrived on site in two weeks. The lights were then distributed by the ShelterBox team on the ground.



The Results: 50,000 people were able to recover faster by using safe, reliable Nokero solar lights. Most of the recipients continue to use the lights 14 months later.
